STRING HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT

There are eight string height adjustment screws, as shown. To raise the strings turn the adjustment screws clockwise. To lower the strings turn the adjustment screws counter-clockwise.



Low string action makes for easier playing but if the strings are too low they will buzz on the frets.

STRING LENGTH ADJUSTMENT

There are four string length adjustment screws, as shown. If a string sounds flat when played at the twelfth fret, compared with the open string harmonic at the same fret, the adjustment screw should be turned counterclockwise to shorten the string. If a string sounds sharp to the harmonic, the screw should be turned clockwise to lengthen the string.

ADJUSTABLE NECK TRUSS ROD

The Neck Adjustment Nut is located at the body end of the neck. If the neck is bowed away from the strings the nut should be tightened (clockwise). If the neck is bowed toward the strings the nut should be loosened (counterclockwise). Use a flat head screwdriver with a tip approximately 1/8" wide (too large a tip will damage the pickguard). Usually a quarter turn or less is required. While turning the screw it is helpful to apply pressure to the neck in the same direction as the required adjustment.

PICKUP ADJUSTMENT

There are two height adjustment screws, one at each end of the pickup. Turn the screws clockwise to raise and counterclockwise to lower the pickup.

Fender Musical Instruments warrants this product to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of one year from date of purchase. The warranty herein extends only to the original purchaser at retail of a new product. This warranty shall not apply to products purchased from anyone other than an authorized Fender dealer, or to products which have been subject to alteration, misuse, accident, neglect (such as extremes of temperature and/or moisture), or to wear resulting from normal usage.

This warranty does not include strings which should be changed periodically, the interval between changes depending on the usage and the player.

The warranty herein becomes effective upon receipt of the completed attached owner registration card within ten (10) days after date of purchase. Upon its receipt the owner will be sent a personalized Fender warranty identification card. Presentation of the card within the warranty period will entitle the owner to receive authorized service and repair from any authorized Fender dealer. Such service and repair shall include all labor and materials necessary to make the repairs and replacements covered under the terms of this warranty.

If the product must be returned to the factory service center for repair, it must be accompanied by an authorized Fender dealer's written direction to such effect and a Fender shipping label. Transportation charges to and from the service center shall be borne by the owner unless otherwise specified by law.

This warranty is expressly in lieu of all other agreements and warranties, express or implied, except as may be otherwise required by law.
