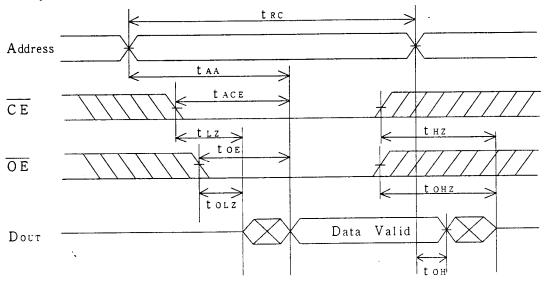

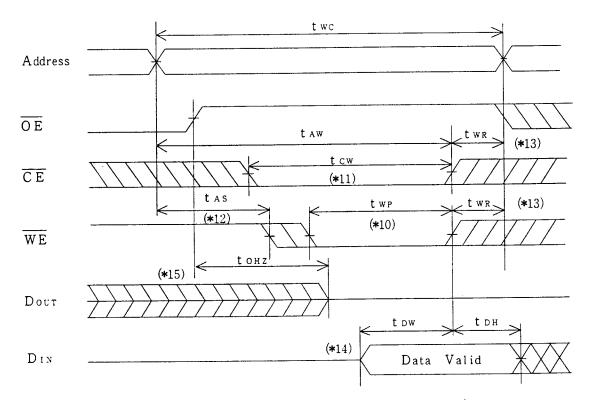

Read cycle timing chart— (*9)

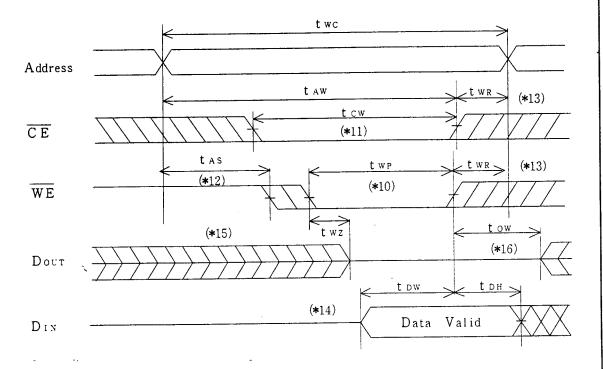
