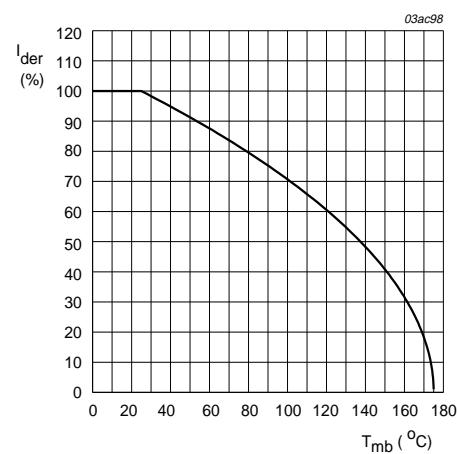

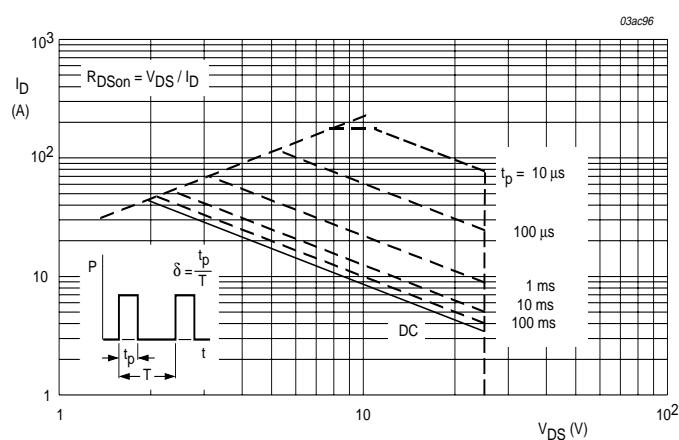

$T_{mb} = 25^{\circ}C$ ;  $I_{DM}$  is single pulse.

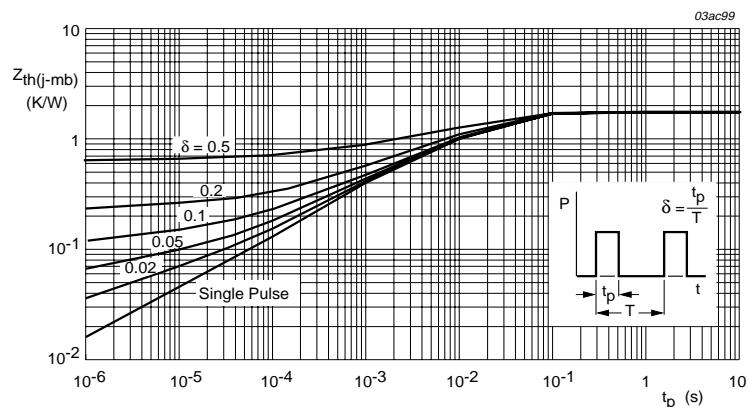
Fig 3. Safe operating area; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage.

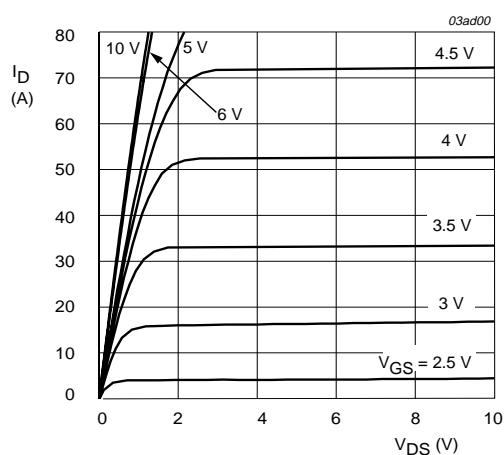
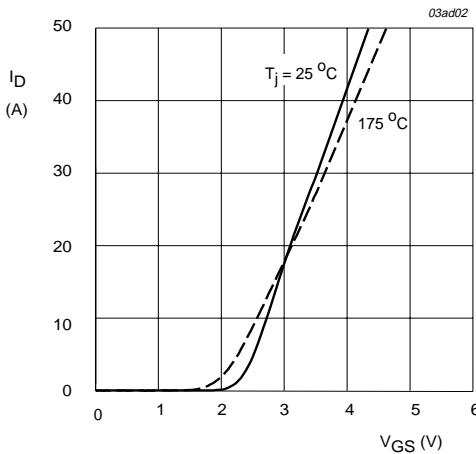
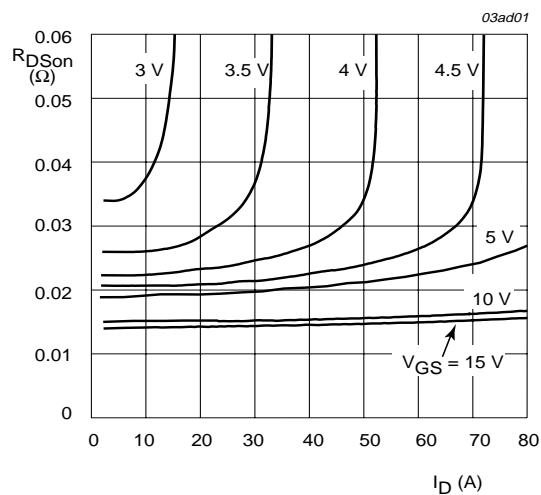
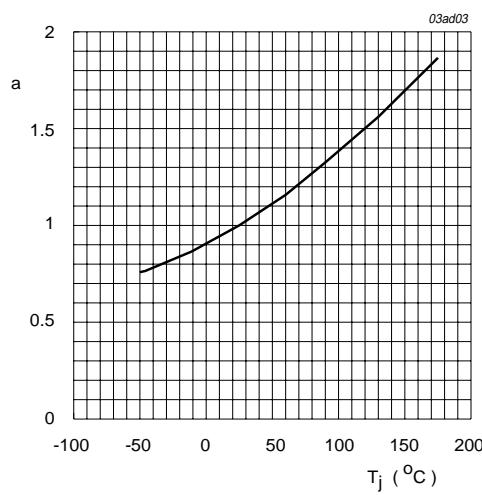


**Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration.**

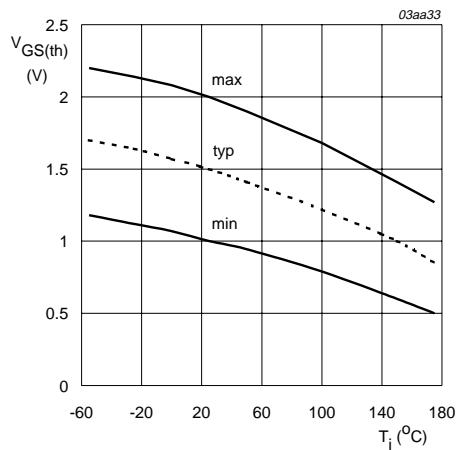

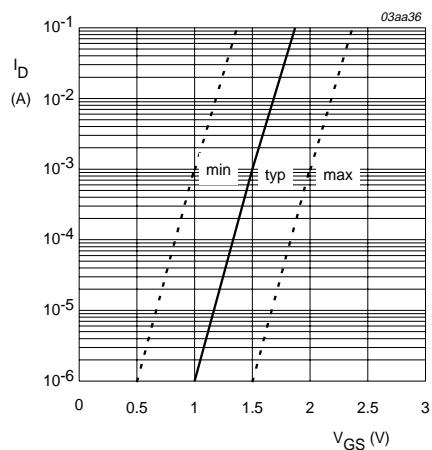

**Fig 8.** Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature.



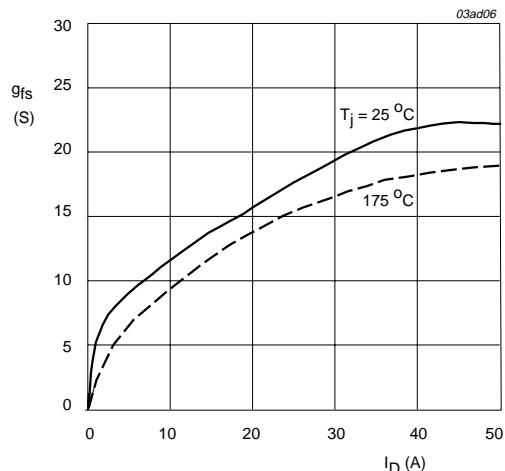

**Fig 9. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature.**



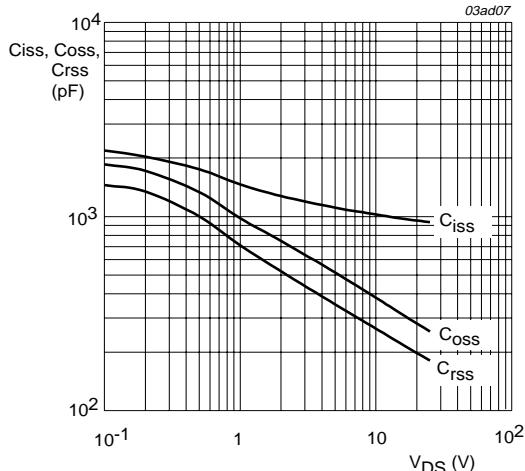

**Fig 10. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage.**



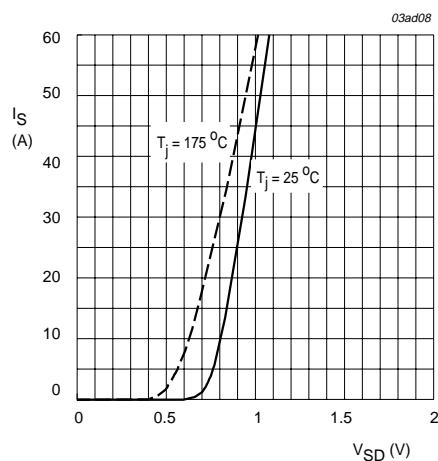

**Fig 11. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values.**



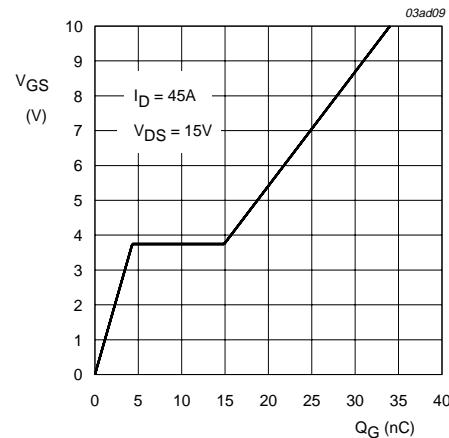

**Fig 13.** Source (diode forward) current as a function of source-drain (diode forward) voltage; typical values.



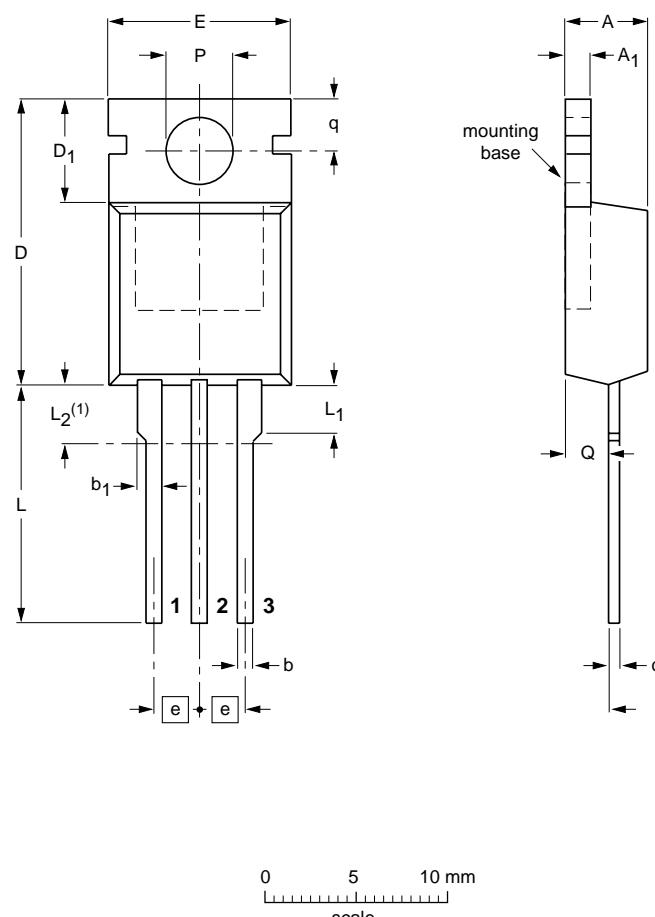

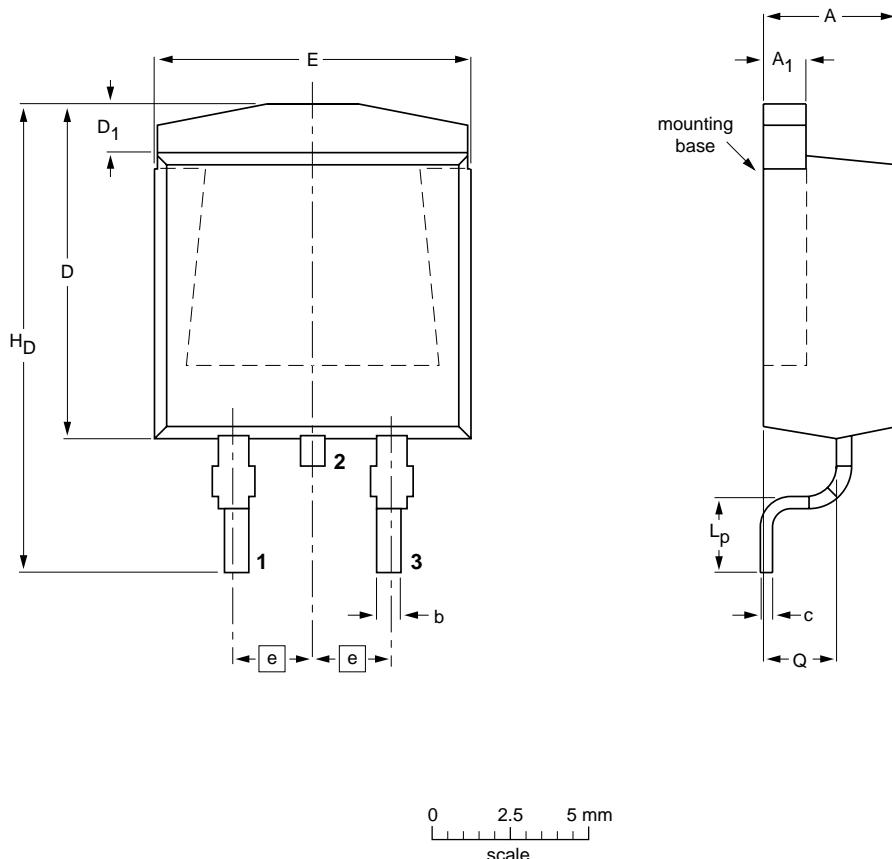

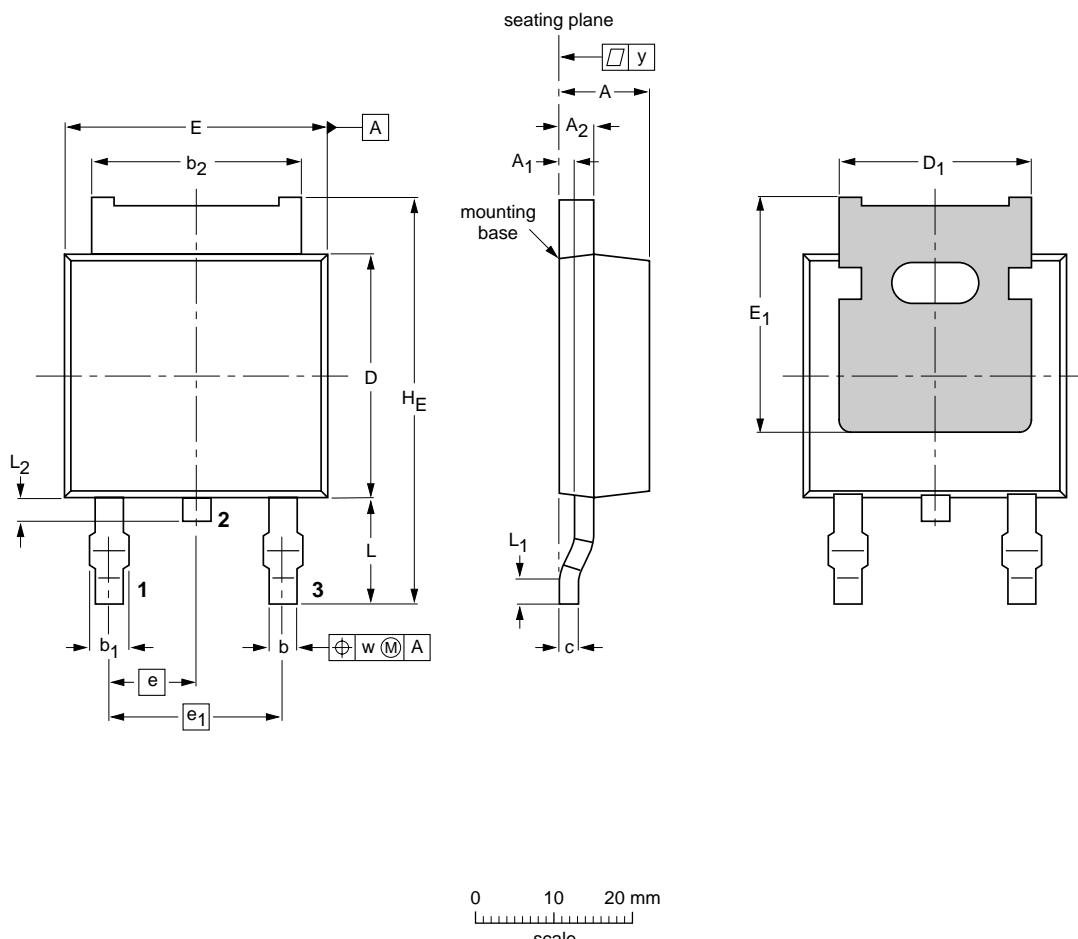
