



### NPN Silicon Digital Transistor







 $V_{CEsat} = f(I_C)$ ,  $h_{FE} = 20$




**Input off voltage**  $V_{i(off)} = f(I_C)$   
 $V_{CE} = 5V$  (common emitter configuration)

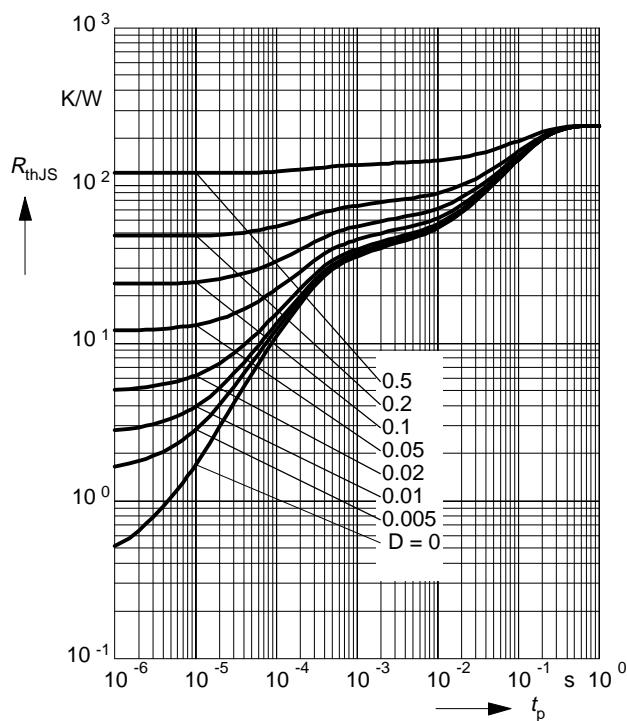


**Total power dissipation**  $P_{\text{tot}} = f(T_A^*; T_S)$
