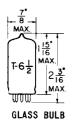

THE 5GH8 IS A SHARP-CUTOFF PENTODE AND A MEDIUM-MU TRIODE CONTAINED IN A 9 PIN MINIATURE ENVELOPE. EACH SECTION HAS A SEPARATE CATHODE AND IS ELECTRICALLY INDEPENDENT. THE PENTODE SECTION IS INTENDED PRIMARILY FOR SERVICE AS AN OSCILLATOR IN THE HORIZONTAL DEFLECTION SYSTEM OF TELEVISION RECEIVERS. EXCEPT FOR HEATER CHARACTERISTICS, THE  $_{\rm 5GH8}$  IS IDENTICAL TO THE 6GH8.
