

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The CK1352P- is a 16-inch electrostatic focus, magnetic deflection, filtered glass faceplate, metal-shell type cathode ray tube with a long persistence screen suitable for radar applications. The additional of a final "A" designates a metalized screen.

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


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Note 1: Reference line is determined by position where reference—line gauge (JEDEC *112) 1.500" + 0.003" -0.000" I.D. and 2" long will rest on funnel.

- Note 2: Socket for this base should not be rigedly mounted; it should have flexible leads and be allowed to move freely.

 Bottom circumference of base shell will fall within circle concentric with metal—shell axis and having diameter of 3".
- Note 3: Metal shell and glass face operate at high voltage. Any material in contact with the shell or the face must be insulated to withstand the maximum applied collector voltage.
- Note 4: A 3 1/4" diameter ring gauge shall fall within the region indicated. (3/4" to 1 3/8" from reference line).



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
