### REPORT OF THE TREASURER FOR 1917

In conformity with Article 15 of the constitution and by direction of the council, the treasurer has the honor to submit the following report for the period December 20, 1916, to December 15, 1917, both inclusive.

The total of cash receipts during the year was \$7,620.42. Disbursements made in accordance with directions of the council amounted to. \$12,127.45. These include \$8,000 for purchase of a like amount of United States Second Liberty Loan Bonds of 1917 for the association and held as an investment.

The total amount of funds of the association, consisting of cash, cost value of securities purchased and appraised value of securities received from the Colburn estate is \$112,644.18
