

## ELECTROPHORESIS APPARATUS

The new Cabinet is slightly more compact than the original model and has a gable cover, new safety interlock system, and platinum wire electrodes. A completely new Power Supply provides either constant potential or constant current output, increased in range to 500 volts and 100 milliamperes, respectively, for research techniques. A second Power Supply, with the same 300-volt, 50-milliampere output characteristics as the earlier model but modified to incorporate the new interlock circuit, is also available for routine separations.

**Cabinet.** Of clear plastic, with gable cover to prevent condensate dropping on sample, easily replaceable platinum wire electrodes, and double-pole safety interlock which prevents removal of cover while current is flowing. Overall dimensions  $10\frac{5}{8} \times 11\frac{5}{8} \times 5\frac{3}{6}$  inches high; can be used in refrigerators, incubators, etc. Takes carrier with four sample strips 40 mm wide or paper sheet up to 185 mm wide; usable migration length 135 mm.

**Power Supply, Model 21.** Provides fully regulated d.c. output; constant potential 0 to 500 volts, or constant current 0 to 100 m.a., for one or two cabinets. Separate dual-range meters indicate current and voltage, respectively. Double-pole relay is incorporated into the safety interlock circuit. When two cabinets are used, current can be read individually and electrode polarity in either can be reversed independently of the other.

**Power Supply, Model 19.** Simple transformer-rectifier type providing unregulated 300-volt, 50 m.a. output. With same double-pole relay protection for safety interlock circuit.

Accessories for Starch Gel, Agar Gel and Micro Immunological Studies. In place of the usual paper strip carrier, a Tray is provided for Starch Gel; a Plate for Agar Gel, and a Carrier for coated micro slides.
