



They are free from lead oxide and therefore suitable for tissue culture work.

The relative absence of brittleness, which has

always been one of the outstanding physical characteristics of Chance micro sheet, greatly reduces breakage in handling and cleaning, particularly of large rectangles.

Sizes most widely used are now packed in a 1 oz. box of polystyrene foam with lift-off cover. Covers can be withdrawn singly without touching the surface. Remaining sizes are packed in small cardboard boxes.
