However, this volume has the distinct advantage of providing a unique synthesis of the ultrastructural and biochemical aspects of a limited range of interrelated topics. Because of this interrelation, it is particularly unfortunate for the reader that this book does not have a subject index. Nor does the book contain any discussion, and the references are given without titles or full pagination. In spite of these shortcomings, the volume is of considerable value both as an introduction to the field for the novice and as an important source of information and reference material for the specialist.

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
