

does not constitute an adequate overview of current social scientific research in northern regions. In particular, the considerable and sophisticated archeological and ethnohistorical research being conducted in all areas of the north is not reported here. The volume does, however, provide an excellent summary of the range and inclusiveness of research on culture change and economic development. Readers, specialist and nonspecialist alike, will note with satisfaction that in all the northern regions scholars are actively engaged in defining patterns of development and assessing the environmental and cultural impact of current government programs.
