The range of topics, including phase transitions, quadrupole resonances, liquid crystals, organic conductors, defects in solids, and so on, is too wide to be treated here, and the reports are for the most part of interest to specialists only. I was particularly struck by the truly elegant demonstration of A. Abragam and co-workers at Saciay that resonance phenomena are not restricted to manifestations of the electromagnetic interaction. Their experiments show that the spin dependence of the nuclear strong interaction between a neutron beam and a polarized proton target can give rise to Larmor precession of the neutrons and other features of magnetic resonance. The consequences may be many for understanding of this most mysterious nuclear force.
