

There are some important omissions in subject matter, however. The book is strong in chemistry and upper-air physics, but it is weak in radiation theory, thermodynamics, and circulation of lower atmospheres. It is nicely produced, but there is no obvious reason why it had to be priced beyond the means of most potential users.

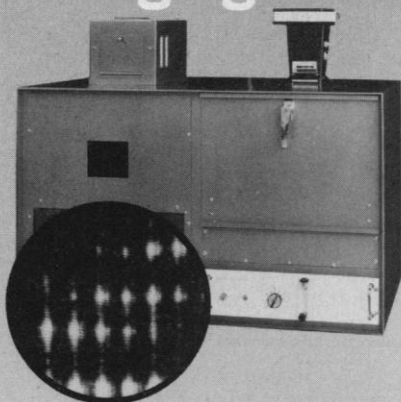

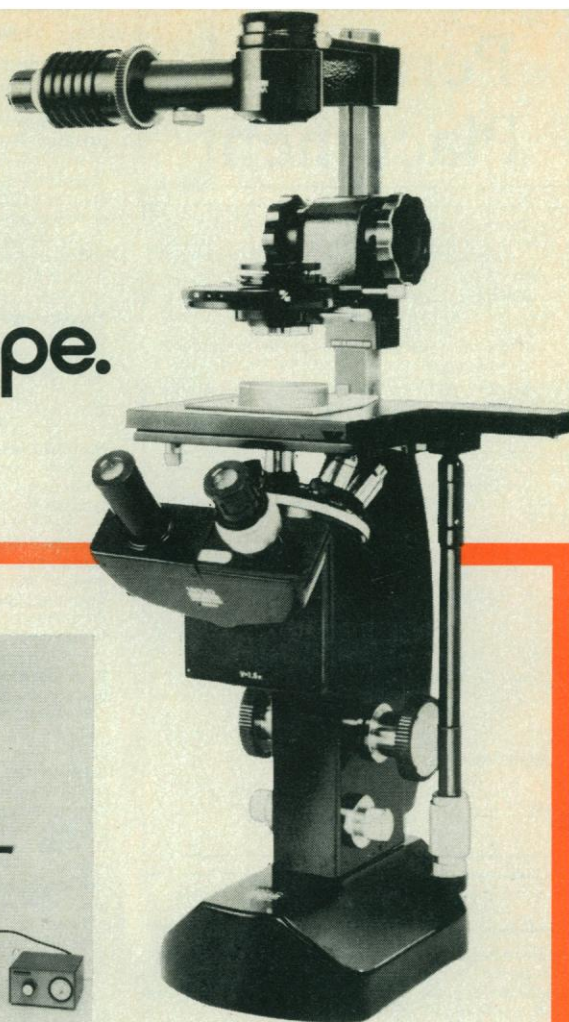
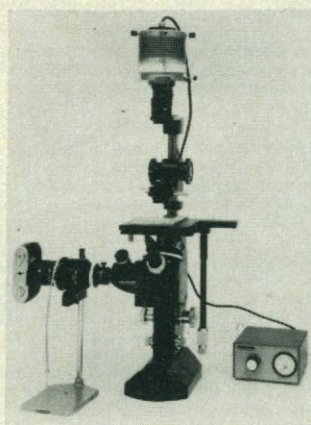
