

imentation in murine systems is the brevity of the chapter on macrophages and their disorders in man (less than 4 percent of the book).

Some of the chapters on topics less frequently reviewed are particularly useful—for example, those on monocyte kinetics in infection, macrophage membranes, and the availability of virus-transformed cell lines of macrophages. Overall the book will be most welcome to research workers in immunology and related fields who wish to be brought up to date concerning recent trends in macrophage research and useful experimental model systems. In addition, it provides most useful and extensive reference lists—a great boon for both experts and newcomers to a field with an immense literature.

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
