well organized and easy to read. For anyone really interested in its topic it is worth reading through, and it will be an indispensable source book for years. The few points on which I might feel able to challenge its conclusions are too recondite to mention. The volume is well produced, with good tables and figures, an occasional harmless misprint, and an adequate index.
