On-Line Services Mushroom at AAAS

Since establishing a site on the World Wide Web in June, AAAS and *Science* have launched a wide range of electronic services that provide more complete access to timely science-related information.

Now, for example, members and browsers can register electronically for AAAS meetings, interact with cast of the "Kinetic City Super Crew" kids' radio program, and get a copy of the most recent *Professional Ethics Report* newsletter. A guide follows:
