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To assure publication of papers with a minimum of delay and to provide readers with subject matter of a wide range and general interest, the AAAS editorial board reaffirms and restates the following policies.

Papers submitted by members and nonmembers of the AAAS will receive equal consideration for publication. Material that is not considered suitable for publication by the board of editors will be returned to the author, and it cannot be the subject of continuing correspondence.

- 1) Lead articles. Lead articles varying in length from about 1000 to 10,000 words are invited for consideration. These may be general articles or reviews of recent advances in some field. Authors should keep in mind the broad audience of Science and should employ reasonably nontechnical language that will be intelligible to most readers.
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
