

Those who are interested in the subjects treated there will find the articles in the first two sections useful. Much of this material has been published several times before, however. The chapters in section 3 are probably the most informative in the book. Like those in sections 1 and 2, they suffer from unevenness of quality and style. The article on the function of sweat glands in domestic animals is singularly unimpressive.

The illustrations in the book are consistently badly designed and reproduced. The few light and electron photomicrographs are little more than organized smudges.

It is useful to have gathered in one book the latest information on the exocrine glands. It is lamentable that the book is so spotty in quality and style.
