

Dewey, and Burke describe some long-lived, deeply subsiding troughs or aulacogens that form at aborted ridge-ridge-ridge triple junctions and show how huge geosynclinal thicknesses can accumulate, contrary to modern dogma, without any lateral plate movement. Both these models have been neglected in recent reconstructions of ancient geosynclines, the first because it lacks igneous and metamorphic activity and the second because consideration of vertical movements has been subordinated to the recently discovered, more spectacular lateral movements.

The Society of Economic Paleontologists and Mineralogists has a deserved reputation for the production of excellent special publications at a price that individuals can afford. Special Publication No. 19 outranks all previous issues in scope and interest to geologists.
