2. How to reach Utrecht (see also <http://www.uu.nl/EN/contactanddirections/Pages/default.aspx>)

- If you arrive by train:

Utrecht can be reached easily by train. There are regular train (several trains per hour) services from all major cities in the Netherlands. For the schedules, please check:

- If you arrived by plane:

Trains from Schiphol (Amsterdam) airport to Utrecht run 4 times an hour (currently at 14, 29, 44, and 59 past the hour). More information on trains and tickets can be found on the national website of the Dutch train company – www.ns.nl. The central hall at Schiphol also acts as the central hall of the train station. The train tracks are down escalators below the floor of the main hall. Trains to Utrecht generally run from platform 1-2. You can buy your train tickets (a single ticket costs approximately €7.70) online through the NS website (<https://www.ns.nl/eticket/ticket?language=en>) or in the station hall from the ticket vending machines or from the booths.

Upon arrival in Utrecht you must go up an escalator from the platform and you will find yourself in the main station hall. Follow the signs to the bus station. Here you can buy an anonymous OV-chipcard, or simply buy a ticket in the bus (ca. 2.50 euro for up to two zones, i.e. till the conference place). At the bus station also taxi's can be found.

3. Declarations:

The form for declarations will be handed out at the conference. This form will require you to provide receipts and bank details (for international transactions this means IBAN numbers) so please have these with you. For flights e-tickets with prices clearly stated should be provided. There will also have to be a conversion of the price into euros. We will help you with this if necessary.

4: Conference Venue:

When arriving and the door is closed, please ring the bell and the door will be opened within a few seconds. The room can be reached by following the stairs to the top floor.

For those who visited Utrecht before, this is behind the Academy building (Domplein). It can be reached using taxi, bus nr. 2, or by a small 15 minutes walk from the Central Railway Station. It is a 3-5 minute walk from the hotel of the participants (the Court hotel) (for a description of the route, see point 7 below).

7. Directions:

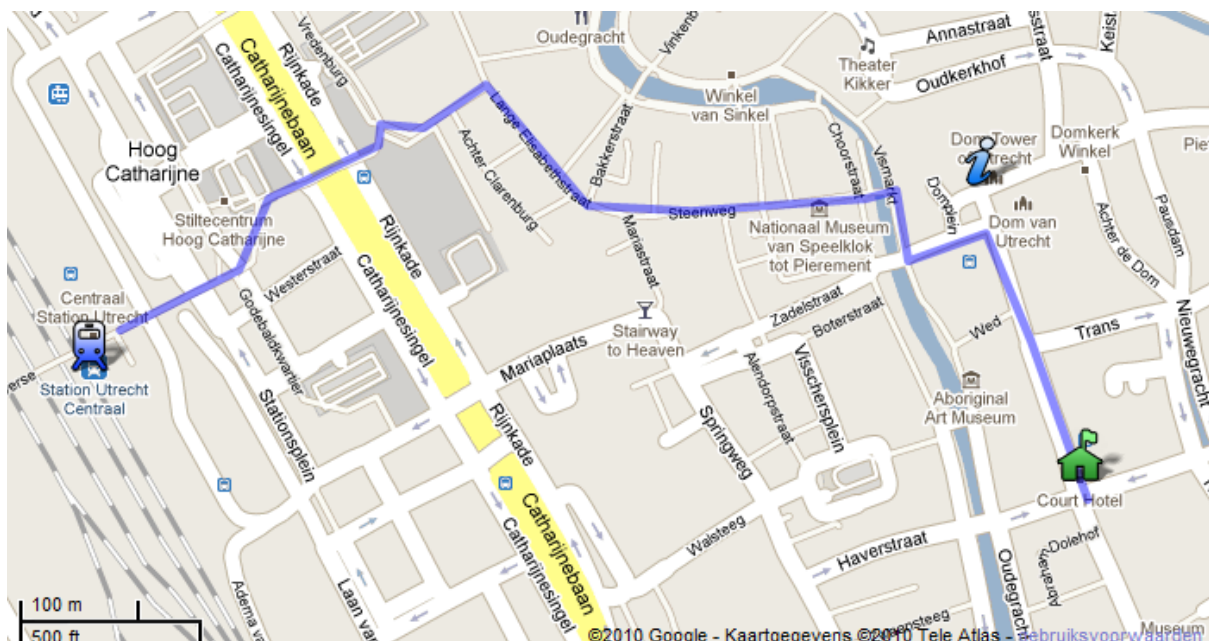
Here follow directions to the main conference venues:

Central Station to the Court Hotel.

- From the central hall of the station follow the signs saying stadsbussen (Hoog Catharijne).
- Take the escalator down to the bus platforms.

- From here you can take busline 2 (direction: museumkwartier, this bus runs on a ring route so there is no chance of getting on it in the wrong direction) to the **Hamburgerstraat** square. This busstop is directly opposite the hotel
- Bus 2 goes four times an hour for most of the day however if you have just missed this bus and if it is after 1900 it is often quicker to get one of the following buses:
- Bus 3 (Burg. F. Andreaelaan), 4 (Burg. F. Andreaelaan), 8 (Overvecht Zuid), 11 (de Uithof), or 211 (Rijnsweerd) to **Janskerkhof** (pronounced Yans-kerk-hof, ask the driver to tell you when you are approaching it if you are unsure) which is the second stop on the route, and from there follow the directions below for Janskerkhof to the Court Hotel
- Alternatively one can walk from central station to the Court Hotel. This journey takes approximately twenty minutes (see map below).

Station to Court Hotel



- Hotel on foot:

- From the central hall of the station walk through the shopping center (Hoog Catharijne) following signs for **Vredenburg**.
- Continue walking straight ahead following the Vredenburg signs, the shopping centre crosses a large road and then a few metres further on there are escalators. Proceed down these escalators and out the glass sliding doors directly in front of you.
- You will have exited onto a large square, the Vredenburg.
- Continue to walk straight ahead down the side of the square until you reach the near right corner, and then turn right onto **Lange Elisabethstraat**.
- Follow this street as it bends and becomes the **Steenweg** and then continue along the narrow opening between the buildings directly in front of you when the Steenweg meets the **Choorstraat**.
- This brings you to **Vismarkt**. Turn right along Vismarkt and then take the first left into the **Servetstraat** which leads under the tower of the Dom.
- Turn right and continue along this street.
- After approximately 200 meters the hotel will be visible on the left hand side of the street.
